The M-20.2 EEBD is a small lightweight, high performance breathing device for escape from IDLH atmospheres. The M-20.2, designed for the marine environment, comes in a rugged case that is water, corrosion and shock resistant to withstand harsh marine conditions. The M-20.2 EEBD can be donned in less than 10 seconds, protecting the wearer from toxic or oxygen deficient atmospheres. The attached clear Teflon hood provides full visibility and is resistant to heat, flame, and chemicals. The case has belt loops allowing the unit to be comfortably worn on the belt for tank inspection. The M-20.2 has a 15-year maintenance free service life (only simple visual inspection by the shipboard personnel every 2 years).
